VISTING RAVENSWOOD VILLAGE NEAR CROWTHORNE

Ravenswood Care Village on Nine Mile Ride near Crowthorne is a great centre of care for vulnerable children, families and people with learning disabilities.

Ravenswood was set up in 1953 by four families aiming to provide education and care for their children and for others with a learning disability. Today, Ravenswood is home to 130 people with learning disabilities living in 13 registered care homes set in over 120 acres of Berkshire countryside.

On my visit I saw first-hand the excellent care provided for its residents as well as the activities on offer as part of its successful sporting programme such as Bocca, Athletics and Football.

Ravenswood Care Village is a facility to be proud of in the Bracknell constituency. The hard work and care provided for residents is outstanding and the individual care provided to residents really opens up opportunities to learn and develop critical skills for their personal development. I was very moved when I met with residents on my visit and I highly commend the staff for their good work.
